

## Memorial Guidelines

The Memorial contains a cemetery where over 5,000 people who died at the Flossenbürg Concentration Camp and on the death marches are buried.

Visitors are asked to respect the dignity of the site and wear appropriate attire.

Children under 10 years of age may visit the Memorial only in the accompaniment of an adult.

Visitors are asked to observe the following additional guidelines:

1. Baby carriages and wheelchairs are permitted on the paths; no other forms of conveyance are permitted.
2. Please remain on the marked paths when touring the grounds.
3. Animals other than guide dogs for the blind are not permitted.
4. Carrying out trade or advertising and distributing printed matter or other materials is prohibited.
5. Photographs and filming for commercial use is prohibited without express permission.
6. Meetings, assemblies and events may be held on the grounds only with express permission.
7. Please do not consume food in the exhibition or on the Memorial grounds.
8. Visitors may not be on the grounds outside of official opening hours.

Paths on the Memorial grounds that have not been cleared of snow and ice are not open to the public; we assume no liability in case of accident.
