The organizer absolves the Free State of Bavaria from any liability as property owners against the organizer or any third party in connection with damages related to this event.

The dignity of the venue is to be upheld through careful handling of the memorial's facilities.

If the cleaning and/or removal of buildings and outdoor facilities, etc., which are used in the event, is not carried out despite a reminder or is carried out insufficiently, the Free State of Bavaria is entitled to arrange this by other means and the organizer is obliged to pay the costs incurred.

The venue is to be left clean and in order.

The following memorial regulations are to be observed:

Memorial Regulations of the Flossenbürg Concentration Camp Memorial

Within the grounds is a cemetery with graves of over 20 000 victims of the Flossenbürg Concentration Camp and its evacuation marches.

We request that you respect the dignity of the setting through appropriate choices of clothing, behaviour and attitudes.

Children under 12 years old may only enter the memorial under the supervision of adults.

The Memorial reserves the right to exclude visitors with misanthropic or racist characters or slogans on their clothing.

Please pay particular attention to:

1. The roads and paths may be used for perambulators and wheelchairs, but not for other vehicles.
2. Please stay on the marked paths.
3. It is not permitted to bring animals onto the grounds, with the exception of guide dogs for the blind.
4. It is forbidden to offer goods of all kinds on the premises, or to distribute pamphlets or other kinds of advertising materials.
5. Photography and filming for commercial purposes is only allowed if written permission from the Memorial has been obtained.
6. Gatherings and events may only take place allowed if written permission from the Memorial has been obtained.
7. Please do not consume food or drink within the exhibitions.
8. It is forbidden to remain on the grounds outside of the opening times.

Public vehicles do not have the right to use un-cleared and un-marked paths. No responsibility will be taken in the case of an accident.
